



NOTICE OF PERMIT HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN to all interested persons within the Prairielands Groundwater Conservation District, consisting of Ellis, Hill, Johnson, and Somervell counties: That the Board of Directors of the Prairielands Groundwater Conservation District (PGCD) will hold hearing(s) on applications for Operating Permits (OP) and/or Permit Amendments by the below listed parties on Monday, October 21, 2024, beginning at 9:00 AM at the District board room located at 208 Kimberly Drive, Cleburne, Texas 76031.

NOTICE is hereby specifically given to:

1. Godley ISD, for a proposed Operating Permit (OP-24-067) for authorization to produce groundwater from an existing well (PGCD-003520) located in Johnson County at 9501 HWY 171, Godley, TX; not to exceed 9,043,000 gallons annually for 2024→2028; Non-Agriculture Irrigation (AK);
2. SDO Freight, LLC, for a proposed Operating Permit (OP-24-068) for authorization to produce groundwater from an existing well (PGCD-003518) located in Johnson County at 201 N. County Road 1226, Cleburne, TX; not to exceed 231,500 gallons annually for 2024→2028; Commercial Use (AK);
3. Avalon WSC, for a proposed amendment to an existing Operating Permit (OP-24-055) to add additional groundwater production authorization in Ellis County located at 213 N FM 55, Italy, TX in the amount of 24,000,000 gallons in 2024 and 44,971,480 gallons each year after; not to exceed a total permitted authorization of 100,000,000 gallons annually thereafter (→2027); Public Water Supply (AK);

If approved, the permit(s) and/or permit amendments requested in the applications above would authorize the permit holder to withdraw groundwater from a water well according to the terms and conditions set forth in the permit. If you would like to contest an application for a permit or permit amendment, you must comply with District Rule 10.6 and either appear at the hearing or submit a written Request for Contested Case Hearing that complies with District Rule 10.6 and that must be received by the District prior to the date of the hearing. A person who submits a written Request for Contested Case Hearing who is unable to appear at the hearing on the date and time set forth above must also timely file a motion for continuance with PGCD demonstrating good cause for the inability to appear.
